4	<p>Trans Pennine Trail</p> <p>Paul Farrand (Senior Planner, Trafford Council) attend the meeting to update the forum on developments.</p> <p>Update agenda item 5 on 23.09.15, “Kickety Brook” the surface in this area has been reviewed. The product used is a new product, the contractor is to attend re rake and roll this stretch.</p> <p>Improvement work started on the section moving east towards A56 from “Kickety Brook” on Monday 16th November 2015 and will continue until approximately Friday 4th December 2015. Diversion signs in place are not clear - PF to review and improve.</p> <p>Amey have been contracted to improve the stretch leading to the Bridgewater Canal including trying to reduce the gradient. This is still in the design stages, but is scheduled for completion by March 16 (part of the submitted list of cycling schemes – LSTF funded).</p> <p>National Grid need to carry out protection works on a pylon close to the River Mersey, the construction access for which is via the TPT.
