2	<p><b>Minutes and matters arising from the last meeting</b></p> <p>Meeting with Canals &amp; River Trust – Update by IS – two exercises taken place aimed to engage with users predominantly focusing on speeding cyclists asking them to be more considerate of other users</p> <p>Previous minutes discussed and agreed as an accurate record</p>		
3	<p><b>Trans Pennine Trail (Inc.' Flooding) – Paul Farrand</b></p> <p>Flooding Carr Green Lane area - investigated water shed on to the area, drains from adjacent farms have been cleared and still a problem. Cess drainage in area needs full survey – source for funding of this to be identified as off highway. Bollin Valley Rangers looking at temporary solutions e.g. route around affected area.</p> <p>Link between BWW and TPT is an Amey project funded via LSTF. TPT section A56 to Hawthorn Lane, Stretford is a priority scheme for 16/17, costs to be obtained once delivery arrangements are in place via Amey Consulting.</p> <p>PF to provide written updates for future meetings.</p> <p>The chair thanked Paul Farrand for attending and providing an update</p>	PF	Ongoing

In light of the Carrington Development (Phase 1 application submitted to planning) Plans for further development in this area will depend on this development.  Remedial works required to the vegetation encroaching onto the cycle/footpath at JTN of spur and Manchester Road and also north of M60 on A56 southbound (Towards Sale). Now dangerous – ST to investigate  Talbot Road – scheme to enhance current provision  Stretford Road – (JTN at Chester Rd) Outline plans and consultation material prepared for a segregated boundary  JTN Talbot Road / Stretford Road Right turn – looking to enhance this for less confident cyclists  Warwick Road South – Footpath between schools – looking to enhance improving width and visibility. Currently in discussions with Diocese of both schools.
